We provide **day services** at our five Day Resources in: Deal, Herne Bay, Margate, Ramsgate, and Sheerness.

Members take part in many activities, including arts and crafts, cooking, woodwork, photography, life skills, fitness, golf, drama, bowling, swimming, dance, gardening, and music.

Throughout the year, members are able to showcase their work at local events and to go out into the community to use local amenities.

Day service is £20.25 for a half day and £40.50 for a full day. You can be referred or you can self-refer.

Alison enjoys socialising with friends and has a good friend who she also sees outside of the day service.

Alison says:

"I have friends who care about me and ask how I am feeling.

I love boxing, I had never done this before. I do lots more exercise now. I have also enjoyed yoga and meditation sessions, which I had never tried before. We also go swimming and do health walks.

If I didn't come to resource I would miss going out to places and would probably just stay home. It makes me feel happy being at resource."

Life Story Project

Hayley Mogridge, a Life Story Facilitator, has been working with five members to record their stories, which can then

be shared and enjoyed for many years to come. Recording life stories can change the way people are perceived and positively influence their future outcomes. It's also a

fantastic way to keep key information and memories.

At the end of the Project, the members will have their own life book or digital life story that is as unique as they are.

Christina said of her digital life story, 'It's a memory for me of my life. I forgot a lot of what I've come through and achieved. It's really done me good and reminded me of positive things in my life.'

Life story work is truly person-centred and shows that every life is important and worth sharing. Hayley said, 'My role enables me to record key information about the person's life in a meaningful way, ensuring their voices get heard. It's priceless and worth shouting about! It's a great way to preserve the past as well as influencing the future.'

GOLD (Getting On with Learning Disabilities) is for people with a learning disability in Thanet who live independently, receive less than 5 hours of support a week, or live with unpaid carers and receive no other support.

Rally

This June, Sue Bates from the GOLD project, and her son Thomas took part in the Fireball Rally Monte Carlo/Eight Countries Challenge, to raise money for East Kent Mencap. Each car was given their next destination when their arrived at the evening campsite so never knew where they were headed and didn't have much time to plan a route. Armed only with a map and a tent, they completed the route in just 7 days.

The route mileage should have been 2,316 miles but with wrong turns and hidden campsites they travelled 2,530, including an extra country, taking in France, Monaco, Italy, Austria, Liechtenstein, Switzerland, Germany, Luxembourg and Belgium! Sue said 'the trip was an experience of a lifetime with breath-taking scenery when driving through the Alps, coastal drives through the French and Italian Riviera, the Italian Lakes and Black Forrest. Even the mountain in Liechtenstein that we camped by was spectacular despite the cloud being so low we could almost touch it!'.

Sue raised an amazing £2,966.81 through personal and organisational donations, by selling advertising spaces on her car, by holding several sweepstakes to guess their Mascot's name (Monty) and some fundraising activities at her son's school. That will help to fund the amazing sessions that GOLD offer for people with a learning disability.

Sue is proud of herself for raising so much money and for completing the trip! And we are so proud of her!
