Winter activities

Lee's chicken pie recipe

Our member Lee was supported by EKM staff to make a chicken and vegetable pie from scratch, and he'd love to share the recipe with you all as the perfect winter warmer!

To make the rough puff pastry:

Put 175g of plain flour, 85g of unsalted butter and a pinch of salt in a bowl. Rub the butter into the flour.

Measure out 1—2 tablespoons of iced water. Add the water gradually as you're mixing to firm up the dough.

Put it in the fridge for 30 minutes.

Roll it into an oblong and then fold in the ends, and repeat this three times.

Put this back into the fridge and now make the pie!

To make the pie:

In a frying pan, fry 500 g of diced chicken in a little oil until brown.

Add 200mls of gravy.

Once the chicken is cooked through, pour the chicken and gravy into an oven proof dish with two handfuls of frozen mixed vegetables.

Roll out your chilled pastry and

place it on top of the filling. Brush the pastry with one beaten egg.

Place the pie in the oven at 180°C and cook until golden brown. Make sure the pie is cooked all the way through. Enjoy with potatoes and mixed vegetables—Tuck in!


Virtual fitness sessions
